

In 1959 Parliament adopted legislation establishing the University College of the Western Cape as a constituent college of the University of South Africa in Pretoria. It was an apartheid institution for people classified as "Coloured". The new college was entirely under white control, with coloured people given only an advisory role. The first group of 166 students enrolled in 1960. What they were offered was limited training for lower to middle level positions in schools, the civil service and other institutions designed to serve a separated Coloured community in 1970, the institution gained University status and a severely qualified independence.
